## CLUB PROGRAMME

Seniors (programmed shoots):

Thu 9:00am, Sat 1:00pm, Sun 1:00pm

Twilight shoots, Tue (6:00pm) during Nov to Mar

Junior Program: Sat 8:30 – 11:00am

Beginners classes: Sun 9:30 – 11:30am

Club meetings are held monthly, 7:30pm, on Tuesday evenings.

After a qualifying requirement, Club members have access to the target butts for practice at any non-programmed time during daylight hours.

## ADELAIDE JUNIOR ARCHERY DEVELOPMENT (AJAD)

The AJAD program caters for the 9 - 18 age group.

Membership can be on a weekly basis (paying for each attendance) or as a Junior member of Adelaide Archery Club (paying only an annual membership fee). Beginner's classes for Juniors are run regularly. Enquires can be made to the AJAD Coordinator at the Club on any Saturday morning before 9:30am.

## BEGINNERS CLASSES

Beginners Classes are held for anyone 12 years old or older, over three consecutive Sunday mornings between 9:30 and 11:30am. Beginners should attend at 9:00am to register and be issued with equipment. These classes are run on a "try before you buy" basis with all equipment supplied and are intended to introduce the beginner to the safe and correct use of target archery equipment. You should wear a snug-fitting top & enclosed shoes. There is no obligation to join the Club. The fee covers tuition, equipment and insurance.

## TRYOUT PERIOD

After completion of the Beginners Classes, you can shoot at the Club at programmed shoots for a tryout period of 4 weeks. The cost covers equipment hire and visitor's fee. After the tryout period, attendance must cease unless an application to join the Club has been submitted.
